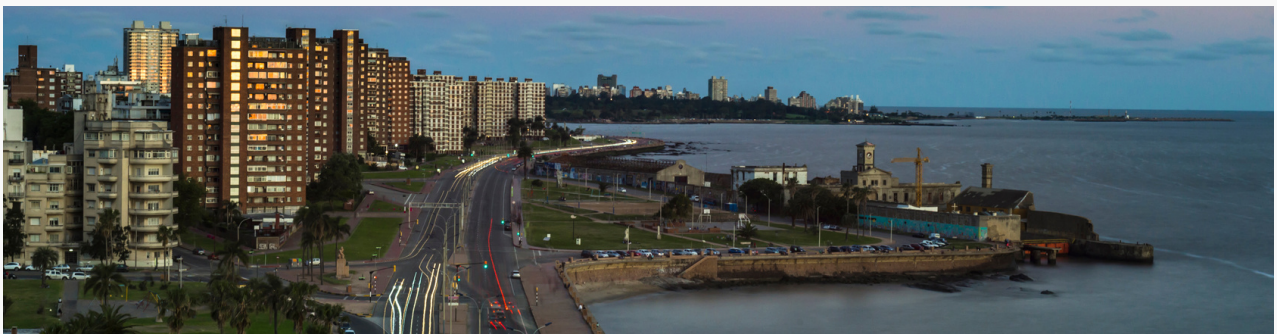
# DESTINATION

# PLACES TO VISIT

## THE RAMBLA OF MONTEVIDEO

Every city has its symbols. The Rambla is one of those that best characterizes Montevideo: an effort of the intrepid that reflects an open society, a common good that speaks of the evolution of its spaces and its people, an encounter between the city and the Río de la Plata that invites aerobic circuits, amateur fishing, and long outdoor walks. The 30 kilometers of coastal promenade make it one of the most socialized coastal spaces in the world.



## PUNTA DEL ESTE

One of the most beautiful beach cities in the continent, located where the waters of the Río de la Plata and the Atlantic Ocean meet. Punta del Este was originally an indigenous site and later a fishing village. In 1907, it acquired the name by which we know it today. It was founded in 1829 by Don Francisco Aguilar, who exploited the area's resources and developed the salting industry. Today, it is a paradise in the eyes of those who have the opportunity to visit it. If you are a lover of sun, beach, gastronomy, and entertainment, there is nothing better than visiting Punta del Este, located in the department of Maldonado in the Republic of Uruguay. The city is known for alternating the peaceful beauty of its natural surroundings of pine forests, crystal clear ocean waters, and expansive beaches of fine sand with the always enticing and exciting nightlife. For several years now, it has become one of the most important beach resorts in Latin America.





## **WINERIES AND VINEYARDS**

Montevideo and Canelones boast a wide variety of wineries where you can engage in wine tourism. These wineries offer guided tours of the vineyards and cellars, allowing visitors to learn about the history of each founding family, the cellar, and the wine-making processes. There is also the opportunity to participate in various activities, including tastings or lunches with traditional Uruguayan barbecue.

## **COLONIA DEL SACRAMENTO**

Universal Value. The Historic Quarter of Colonia del Sacramento was inscribed on the World Heritage List during the 19th Session of the World Heritage Committee held in Berlin from December 4th to 9th, 1995. The urban layout of Colonia del Sacramento



represents the only example in the Río de la Plata region of a city design that does not adhere to the rigid grid pattern imposed by Spain on its colonies in the Americas. Indeed, the urban layout, typically Portuguese, harmoniously adapts to the topography of the area, forming qualified and surprising spatialities.

The attributes that represent it are also formed by the architectural values, illustrative of a modest rural and urban area from the initial period of Portuguese and then Spanish occupation.

Emphasizing the historical importance of the city during the 17th century and beyond, its current relevance should be considered, as the City of Colonia is the main entry and exit point for visitors to the country. The distance separating it from Buenos Aires allows it to be considered as a heritage resource reflected in significant tourist attraction for Uruguay.



# THINGS TO DO

The Uruguayan city that receives the most tourists each year is Montevideo. It is also the capital, the most populous city, and the one that offers the most activities to do and places to visit.

Montevideo is a city different from the rest of the capitals in Latin America. It stands out for its culture, its historical buildings, its waterfront promenade, its gastronomy, and for the friendliness and politeness of its people, who you will see at all times with the *mate* in hand and the thermos under their arm.

Modernism and tradition blend in the Uruguayan capital alongside an active social life. There is always something to do in Montevideo.
